DISTRIBUTION. Russia: Altai (first record), Yakutia, Irkutsk, Amur, Khabarovsk, Primorye. North East China.

Gitona distigma Meigen, 1830

MATERIAL. 3♂, 2♀. Altai Republic: Chermal district, left bank of Katun' River, Mezhelik Mt., 2.X 1999; Uznezya village, 18.XI 1999; Askat village, 20.XI 1999.

DISTRIBUTION. Russia: Altai (first record), European part, Caucasus, West and East Siberia, Far East. Europe, Kazakhstan, Mongolia, North China.

Leucophenga (Neoleucophenga) quinquemaculipennis Okada, 1956

MATERIAL. 2♂. Altai Republic: vic. of Askat village, VIII 2001.

DISTRIBUTION. Russia: Altai (first record), East Siberia, Far East. North East China, Korea, Japan.

Chimomyza amoena (Loew, 1862)

MATERIAL. 1♀. Altai Republic: vic. of Askat village, VIII 2001.

DISTRIBUTION. Russia: Altai (first record), center of European part, North Caucasus. Central Europe, North America.
