Lelej A. S. FIRST RECORD OF BETHYLID WASPS (HYMENOPTERA, BETHYLIDAE) FROM THE KURIL ISLANDS - Far Eastern Entomologist. 1997. N 38: 7.

During the expedition of International Kuril Island Project (IKIP) in 1996 a series of small wasps has been collected. These specimens were identified as *Bethylus fuscicornis* from the family Bethylidae. This family distributed mainly in southern regions of Far East [1] but still unknown from Kuril Islands. All material deposited in the Institute of Biology and Pedology, Vladivostok.
